Workshop

The workshop is for dancers who know the basic steps (Skip Change, Slip Step, Pas De Basque, Strathspey travelling and setting), as well as Reels of 3 and 4, Corner figures, Poussette, and Allemande.

Tracey Applebee is our teacher. Tracey is a Certified RSCDS Teacher who has taught classes and workshop in the USA and Canada. She was first exposed to Scottish County Dance growing up in Canada. Her parents (her mother having received her certificate from Miss Milligan) would have dance parties in the basement dancing to Jimmy Shand on a portable record player. The family moved to Detroit and began dancing with the Windsor, Ontario branch. The teachers there encouraged Tracey to attend TAC summer school at Brock and this wonderful experience cemented her love of the hobby.

Tracey received her full certificate in 1994 at TAC and has been actively teaching the Cincinnati branch at all levels since then. Additionally, she has taught at dance workshops all over the Midwest, in Windsor, Montreal, Hamilton, and Asilomar. She has taught afternoon classes at TAC, and this summer is looking forward to being one of the core teachers at the Vancouver summer school.

As an occupational therapist, she loves the analysis of movement that can improve everyone's dancing and their enjoyment of the dance. She is thrilled to be coming to Midway to teach our workshop.
